Step 1: Register with iSportsman

- Click on Register

Acknowledgements

- After saving your registration information you will be asked to acknowledge a few pieces of information.
- You must click "I affirm" in order to move forward and purchase permits.



Initially, users will have no permits on their profile. To purchase a permit, click either "Available Permits" on the blue bar or the "Acquire Permits" button on the account home page. Both of these buttons will take you to the list of available permits.

Step 3: Checking in to an Activity Checking in a Participant (with a Participant Permit)

- PARTICIPANTS are individuals that will participate in a hunting or fishing activity as a "guest".
- If you <u>do not have a participating guest</u>, click NO and move on to the check-in confirmation.
- If you are <u>sponsoring a participant</u>, you must check them in under your profile on this step.
- Your participant must have purchased a hunting or fishing participant permit and have their permit number. Enter their permit number and the initial of their last name and click "Add Participant". You can add up to 2 participants for fishing and small game hunting.

Checking in a Non-participating Guest (Observer)

- GUESTS are individuals who are observing while you hunt or fish and not participating in the activity.
- If you have any <u>non-participating guests</u> or <u>observers</u>, then you will check them in here. DO NOT check in Participants (participating guests) in this step. They should be checked-in in the previous step!
- These non-participating guests <u>do not require a permit</u>. You will check them in using their <u>first and last name</u> and <u>date of</u> <u>birth</u>.

Reporting Harvest for Hunting and Fishing

If you were hunting or fishing, iSportsman will ask if you caught/harvested anything.

Special Permit Types

- Disabled (DAV) Hunting/Fishing Permits
- Gratis/Senior Hunting/Fishing Permits
- Youth Hunting/Fishing Permits
- Participant Hunting/Fishing Permits
- Transition Hunting and Fishing permits.
- Cycling Permit

Disability Hunting/Fishing Permits

- Anyone who is service-related disabled can receive a free (DAV) fishing permit. Hunting (DAV) permits cost \$15.00
- You must possess a State disability license from the S.C. Dept. of Natural Resources to qualify.

Gratis/Senior Fishing and Hunting Permits

- Gratis Fishing permits for anglers 64 years of age or older who possess a S.C. Gratis or Senior fishing license.
- Senior Hunting permit for hunters 64 years of age or older who possess a S.C. Gratis or Senior hunting license. Permit cost \$15.00

Youth Permits

Youth (15 and under) must create an iSportsman

- profile and obtain a free youth hunting and/or youth fishing permit
- All youth participating in hunting activities, must have completed a state Hunter Education Coure and the Fort Jackson Hunter Safety Briefing.

All youth hunters (16 and under) must be accompanied

 by an adult with a Fort Jackson hunting permit while hunting on Fort Jackson.

All youth anglers (15 and under) must be accompanied by an adult with a Fort Jackson fishing permit while

fishing on Fort Jackson.

Participant (Guest) Permits

- Individuals wishing to participate in hunting or fishing activities as a guest are referred to as <u>PARTICIPANTS</u> in iSportsman. GUESTS (as referred to in iSportsman) are observers and cannot participate in the hunting/fishing activity.
- Sponsors DO NOT purchase the permit for their participants. Participants must create their own profile and *purchase their own permit*. Participants can purchase a 1-day or annual hunting or fishing participant permit.
- Sponsors will check in their participant on the day of hunting/fishing using their <u>permit number</u> and <u>initial</u>.
- Sponsors and participants will check out separately and report harvest separately.

Transition Permits

- Free Transition Permits are required of patrons who currently hold a valid Fort Jackson hunting and/or fishing permit (purchased prior to iSportsman implementation), and the permit has not yet expired.
- Transition permits are to be printed and carried with you along with your valid hunting and/or fishing permit.

Cycling Permits

- Free Cycling Permits are required for individuals who ride or run the Range-Area Cycling Loop. They are not required of cyclists and runners who ride or run in the cantonment area only.
- Cyclists and runners should reference the "Cyling" page under "Acivities" for more information.
